Gabriel Pulliam 5'5 Wallace Middle (Waterbury, CT – 2013)

Gabriel Pulliam impressed with his speed in the open court and athleticism while finishing at the basket. Pulliam hit the outside shot with consistence and also found teammates open down low for easy baskets.



Rashon Davis 5'5 Lincoln Middle (Meriden, CT – 2013)

Rashon Davis's speed and energy is a big part of his game at this stage. Davis has good ball handling skills and is a good on ball defender.

Zach Campbell (not pictured) 5'9 Amity Middle (Woodbridge, CT – 2013)

Nick Boccanfuso 5'6 (Norwalk, CT – 2013)

Nick Boccanfuso has continued to improve his basketball skills and aggressiveness through the four adidas Phenom Regional Camps he has been evaluated in. Boccanfuso sprinted in transition handling the ball with comfort and finding teammates on the break. Boccanfuso showed up an array of spin moves that helped him get to the free throw line and or finish at the basket with confused defenders. Boccanfuso's mid-range perimeter shot has improved and defensive intensity on the ball has helped create turnovers.
