Romeo Bouie - Horlick High School in Racine, Wisconsin

The annual fall adidas Phenom Camp, College Showcase, and Skills Camp hosted by Elite Sports and Jay Riccitelli was loaded again this year with 400 total players from 8 states and 3 countries.

Marcus Blackwell – Notre Dame-Fairfield (Fairfield, CT) – Bridgeport – Class of 2015 – dominated at both ends of the floor playing with the 10-12 graders in the HS Showcase on Saturday night. Blackwell stands 6'2 with a college like frame that plays like a high school veteran. He pushes the ball up the floor and in transition like a point guard, shoots the ball from the wing like a shooting guard, and finishes strong in the paint and around the basket like a power forward.

Clinton Davidson - Notre Dame-Fairfield (Fairfield, CT) – Bridgeport – Class of 2015 – is a speedy point guard that plays intensely on both sides of the floor. His quickness gave opponents problems at the top of the key as they were not able to get around him and often he stole the ball for easy layups. Davidson pushed the ball up the floor in transition and found teammates for scores and also hit open shots on the perimeter.

Justin Campbell – Career High School (New Haven, CT) – Hamden – Class of 2015 – is a long forward that changes shots on the wing and in the paint often getting a hand on shots and passes. Campbell rebounds well and finishes in the paint and on the block.

Romeo Bouie - Horlick High School (Racine, Wisconsin) Class of 2015 – was one of the top 2 underclassmen prospects who made the trip from Wisconsin to CT to prove he can play with the top players in the Tri-State / New England area. Bouie did just that by dominating the competition in the class of 2015 and fitting in just right with the top players in the class of 2012-2014. Bouie is a 6'3 athletic wing that has the potential to be a mid to high major DI college player. He shoots the ball well from the perimeter, but his game is slashing from the wing and finishing at the rim. In the paint Bouie is strong enough to finish through contact and in the open floor he is unstoppable.

Devon Marsh – Master's Prep School (West Simsbury, CT) – Bloomfield – Class of 2015 – 6'6 wing / small forward slashes to the basket from the wing and finishes above the rim at times. Very active down low altering shots and rebounding the ball well.

Trayson Patterson – East Hartford HS (East Hartford, CT) – Class of 2015 – long aggressive wing – small forward that plays at a high tempo on both ends of the floor. Patterson runs the floor in transition and finishes strong. He defends well and blocks shots.

Donte Peeler - Notre Dame-Fairfield (Fairfield, CT) – Bridgeport – Class of 2015 – is a big wide strong body that creates problems in the paint defensively and rebounds the ball well.

John Richitelli – Barlow High School (Redding, CT) – Easton – Class of 2015 – stands about 6'4 with long arms and good footwork. He works hard in the post with a nice drop step and is active on the boards. Richitelli also runs the floor and finishes in transition. Boxes out well and uses his body for good positioning.

Thomas Nolan – Fairfield Prep (Fairfield, CT) – tuff guard that plays fast on both ends of the floor. Nolan is very active on offense moving without the ball and attacking the basket with the ball and defensively getting in passing lanes and crashing the basket for rebounds. Good outside shot on the perimeter as well.

Nate Williams – (PA) – Class of 2015 – is an aggressive offensive player that attacked the rim on most possessions often finishing with contact. Williams is big and strong and played with high confidence as he did what he wanted to do in most games. He shot the ball well from the perimeter showing his range hitting from behind the arc.

Jonathan Nwankwo – Iona Prep (NY) – Class of 2015 – this tall 6'10 forward has the size to play DI basketball. Chukwu finished layups around the basket and rebounded well. His 7'0 wing span altered and blocked shots on the wing and in the paint.

Keyshawn Patterson - Hartford Magnet HS (Hartford, CT) – Class of 2015 – extremely quick guard that handles the ball well and blows by defenders on his way into the paint to pull up, use his floater, or find teammates for buckets.

Dondre Daniels – Bridgeport Central HS (Bridgeport, CT) – Class of 2015 – speedy guard with good ball handing skills and sees the floor well. Daniels pushes the ball in transition.

Jordan Robinson – Middletown HS (Middletown, CT) – Class of 2015 – long fast guard that uses his speedy dribble to get by defenders and score at the rack or dish to teammates for buckets. Robinson is automatic in transition pushing the ball up the floor at a fast pace.

Tracey Rumley – Platt HS (Meriden, CT) – Class of 2015 – is a very talented fast guard that handles the ball well in transition beating defenders down the floor to finish at the basket and uses his ball handling skills to blow by defenders in the half court set. Rumley used his speed to create his own shot and often made very good passes to teammates in scoring position.

Tim Flynn – Classical Magnet HS (Hartford, CT) – Class of 2015 – big talented guard that plays at a high tempo. Flynn handles the ball on the perimeter well and will pull up and take the shot. He also slashed to the basket and finished at the rim over defenders.

Kerry Raymond – (MA) – Class of 2015 – Good shot blocker and defender.

Mark Byrne – Fairfield Warde HS (Fairfield, CT) – Class of 2015 – cut well without the ball getting himself in open space for an open shot or getting the ball behind the defense around the basketball for easy layups.

Paul Bentley – Bloomfield HS (Bloomfield, CT) – Class of 2015 – speedy ball handler that attacks the hoop with a nice hesitation move and hop step.

Jordan Riullano – (NY) – Class of 2015 – aggressive guard with good size and strength. Good knowledge of the game that helps him be on the floor in the right spots by making timely cuts and using his dribble to find his own shot or create a better passing lane to find teammates for scores.

William Hardie – East Hartford HS (East Hartford, CT) – Class of 2015 – long wing – small forward that plays hard and finishes around the basket.

Nick Esposito – Staples HS (Westport, CT) – Class of 2015 – long 6’4 frame that is active around the basket finishing around the hoop and rebounding well.
