Drew Crudup impressed coaches in both showcase games showing off incredible speed, athleticism, and leading ability. **Crudup's** first step had him past the defender every time finishing with a dunk or reverse layup. The 6' combo guard found players in transition for easy scores and played well defensively. **Crudup** had several explosive dunks with that caught the eye of everyone in the gym.



Kevin Leumene (#22) stood out as the top shooter at camp hitting at least 80% of his shots. Leumene was very confident from the perimeter pulling up from long distance and hitting four 3's in a row at one point. The 6'1 SG was able to pull up off the dribble in transition and create his shot using his dribble.



Dante Thompson showed a complete game finishing strong down low with dunks, lay-ups, and put backs. The strong and physical 6'7 F went to the basket with ease and looked good from the perimeter hitting a couple of three's.



Timajh Parker-Rivera stood out with multiple blocked shots and quick scores from 12 feet in. Parker's long 6'7 frame and long arms was a constant game changer defensively.

Tyrell Henderson (no pic) scored in bunches as the lefty hit three's from the wing and corner and finished in transition. The 6'1 Combo Guard showed good speed and athleticism.



James Jennings controlled the tempo in both showcase games pushing the ball up the floor and making passes up court and cross court to teammates for scores. The 5'8 PG is fast and strong.

Billy McDonald (no pic) looked fresh playing above the rim dunking everything inside. McDonald is a strong and athletic 6'7 SF that rebounds the ball well.



Luciano Martinez (white jersey) was an offensive threat hitting multiple three's in both games and finishing in transition. The 6'3 SG pushed the ball up the floor and found teammates in transition and showed off his range behind the line.



Jamill Powell slashed to the basket and finished at the rim in both showcase games. The 6'5 wing show off his range hitting from the perimeter consistently.



Pat Hopkins (#3) ran the floor well and rebounded the ball well. The 6'7 F hit from the free throw line and in.



Kyle Holmes was strong and fast blowing by the defenders in transition and finishing at the basket. The 6'0 combo guard is very physical and explosive.



Aaron Bartley is a wiry guard who continued to crash the boards and clean up missed shots. The 6'2 guard has a motor that does not stop. **Bartley** put the ball on the floor and drove to the basket and ran the floor in transition.

Najee Duncan (no pic) pushed the ball up the floor in transition finding teammates for layups. The 6'1 G also showed off his range in the 2nd game hitting a couple of perimeter shots including a three.



Arkel Miles was a big presence inside bullying defenders and finishing strong. The 6'4 F plays very physical and rebounds the ball well.

Dylan Benz (no pic) showed great speed pushing the ball in transition and blowing by defenders. The 5'11 PG has great court vision and finds the open man.



Devin Coleman shot the ball well hitting from the perimeter in both games. The 6'0 G handled the ball well and finished in transition.

Antwan Boyd (no pic) is a long and athletic G that slashes to the basket and finishes around the hoop.
